I. WORLD PRESS SUMMARY - INTERNATIONAL NEWS

"WORKING PEOPLE WILL NOT ALLOW PORTUGAL TO BECOME ANOTHER CHILE"

SEPT. 10 (IPS)--THE UNITY COMMISSION OF THE WORKERS AT THE LARGEST INDUSTRIAL MONOPOLY IN PORTUGAL, CUF, STATED IN A POSITION PAPER THAT THE WORKING CLASS "WOULD NOT ALLOW PORTUGAL TO BECOME ANOTHER CHILE." THE WORKERS OF THE CUF COMPANY EM-PHASIZED THAT THE "PRESENT POLITICAL INSECURITY AND THE MACHINATION OF THE RIGHT WING FORCES IN THE ARMY, SERVE THE INTERESTS OF THE COUNTERREVOLUTION." THEY EXPRESSED THEIR DETERMINATION THAT "THE REVOLUTIONARY PROCESS WOULD NOT BE LOST IN FAVOR OF THE BOURGEOISIE," ACCORDING TO THE EAST GERMAN COMMUNIST PARTY PAPER NEUES DEUTSCHLAND TODAY.

PCP ACCUSES THE PPD OF INSURRECTION AND CIVIL WAR

SEPT. 10 (IPS)--THE PORTUGUESE COMMUNIST PARTY (PCP) TODAY AC-CUSED THE PORTUGUESE DEMOCRATIC PARTY OF WORKING TOWARDS "COUNTER-REVOLUTION, SUBVERSION, INSURRECTION AND CIVIL WAR THROUGH ITS ARMED BANDS," ACCORDING TO UPI TODAY. THIS WEEKEND IN PORTO, THE HEAD OF THE PPD, EMIDIO GUERREIRO "ANNOUNCED THE FORMATION OF A CIVIL WAR ARMY OF 50,000 MEN, AND HE RAISED THE DEMAND FOR THE IMMEDIATE DISSOLUTION OF THE ARMED FORCES MOVEMENT (MFA) AND OF THE REVOLUTIONARY COUNCIL," ACCORDING TO TO-DAY'S NEUES DEUTSCHLAND, THE PAPER OF THE EAST GERMAN COMMUNIST PARTY.

> ANTI-PCP COMMISSION TO STUDY RESTRUCTURING OF PORTUGUESE ARMED FORCES

SEPT. 10 (IPS)--CAPTAIN VASCO LOURENCO, ONE OF THE "NINE" WHO SIGNED A DOCUMENT FOR THE OVERTHROW OF THE GONCALVES GOVERNMENT, WILL HEAD A STUDY COMMISSION FOR THE RESTRUCTURING OF THE ARMED FORCES MOVEMENT (MFA) AND THE REVOLUTIONARY COUNCIL, ACCORDING TO TODAY'S WASHINGTON POST. INCLUDED ON THIS COMMISSION ARE THE HEADS OF THE THREE BRANCHES OF THE ARMED FORCES, TWO OF WHOM ARE OPENLY ANTI-GONCALVES. "THE COMMISSION APPEARS CERTAIN TO BE WEIGHTED HEAVILY AGAINST THE COMMUNISTS," CONCLUDES THE POST.

SOVIET TRADE MINISTER RECEIVES FRENCH DELEGATION

SEPT. 10 (IPS)--SOVIET MINISTER OF FOREIGN TRADE NIKOLAI PATOLICHEV MET MONDAY WITH THE FRENCH MINISTER OF INDUSTRY AND SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH MICHEL D'ORNANO, REPORTED PRAVDA YESTERDAY. IPS/09.10.1900/PAGE TWO

THE TALKS FOCUSSED ON LARGE-SCALE JOINT INDUSTRIAL PROJECTS.

3,000 DEMONSTRATE AGAINST FRENCH GOVT RELAUNCHING PLAN

SEPT. 10 (IPS)--3,000 WORKING CLASS DEMONSTRATORS, LED BY THE COMMUNIST AND SOCIALIST ALLIED TRADE UNIONS, THE CGT AND CFDT, YESTERDAY DEMONSTRATED OUTSIDE THE FRENCH NATIONAL ASSEMBLY AG-AINST THE GISCARD D'ESTAING GOVERNMENT'S ANTI-WORKING CLASS RE-FLATIONARY ECONOMIC PROGRAM. DEBATE ON THE PROGRAM WILL CONTINUE TODAY WITH PRESENTATIONS BY FRENCH COMMUNIST PARTY (PCF) SECRE-TARY GENERAL GEORGES MARCHAIS AND GAULLIST LEADER MICHEL DEBRE, THE PCF DAILY L'HUMANITE REPORTS.

JAPANESE INDUSTRIALISTS IN EAST GERMANY

SEPT. 10 (IPS) -- A DELEGATION OF OVER TWENTY LEADING JAPANESE IN-DUSTRIALISTS HAVE ARRIVED IN BERLIN FOR A MEETING OF THE GERMAN DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC - JAPAN ECONOMIC SOCIETY, REPORTS NEUES DEUTSCHLAND TODAY IN A FRONT PAGE ARTICLE. THE DELEGATION, LED BY NIPPON STEEL BOARD CHAIRMAN INAYAMA, WAS GREETED BY GDR PARTY SECRETARY ERICH HONECKER. INAYAMA SAID HIS DELEGATION CONSIDERS LONG-TERM ECONOMIC AND SCIENTIFIC PROJECTS PARTICULARLY IMPORTANT.

> CHIRAC CALLS FOR A MIDEAST "GLOBAL AGREEMENT AS SOON AS POSSIBLE"

SEPT. 10 (IPS)——FRESH FROM FOUR DAYS OF EXTENSIVE MEETINGS WITH IRAQI VICE—PRESIDENT SADDAM HUSSEIN, FRENCH PRIME MINISTER JACQUES CHIRAC YESTERDAT CALLED FOR "A GLOBAL AGREEMENT" IN THE MIDEAST "AS SOON AS POSSIBLE," ACCORDING TO FRENCO'S LE MONDE NEWSPAPER.

CHIRAC FURTHER CALLED FOR "STRONG AND TIGHT LINKS" TO BE CREATED BETWEEN A UNIFIED ARAB SECTOR AND A UNIFIED EUROPE, A CON-CEPTION THE IRAQIS STRONGLY SHARE.

EGYPTIAN NEWSPAPER DELETES SADAT ANTI-SOVIET DIATRIBES

SEPT. 10 (IPS)--AL AHRAM, EGYPT'S INFLUENTIAL "SEMI-OFFICIAL" DAILY, LAST WEEK DELETED FROM ITS TRANSCRIPT OF PRESIDENT ANWAR SADAT'S POST-SINAI PACT ADDRESS ALL OF SADAT'S RABID ATTACKS ON THE SOVIETS. AL AHRAM MAINTAINS A CONSISTENT "NEUTRALIST" POSE, TRYING TO UPHOLD AN EGYPTIAN "BALANCE" BETWEEN THE U.S. AND THE SOVIETS.

EAST GERMAN OFFICIAL CALLS FOR GENEVA CONFERENCE

SEPT. 10 (IPS) --- IN AN OFFICIAL BROADCAST OVER STIMME DER DDR, EAST GERMAN RADIO, EAST GERMAN OFFICIAL MOLDT STATED TODAY, "THE GENEVA CONFERENCE IS THE ONLY MEDIUM TO SETTLE PEACE IN THE MIDEAST." MOLDT NOTED THAT GENEVA WOULD BE THE BEST FORUM TO DIS-CUSS ISRAELI TERRITORIAL WITHDRAWALS AND THE RESOLUTION OF THE RIGHTS OF THE PALESTINIANS.

THE CURRENT ISSUE OF THE EAST GERMAN WEEKLY HORIZONT ALSO CALLS FOR THE RECONVENING OF THE GENEVA CONFERENCE.

LEBANESE LEFTISTS PREPARE TO FIGHT

SEPT. 10 (IPS)--EYE-WITNESSES IN NORTHERN LEBANON ARE REPORTING "THE FIRST EMBRYONIC PATROLS BY LEFT-WINGERS AND PALESTINIAN COMMANDOS" IN THE CITY OF TRIPOLI, ACCORDING TO TODAY'S BALTIMORE SUN. THE SUN FURTHER NOTES THAT MOSLEM AND LEFTIST GROUPS HAVE "MERGED INTO A PRIVATE ARMY OF 3,000 MEN" WHO "WERE REPORTED TAKING UP POSITIONS IN VILLAGES NEAR THE CHRISTIAN HILL TOWN OF ZGHORTA," A FASCIST STRONGHOLD.

NUMEROUS SOURCES MEANWHILE REPORT THAT THE LEBANESE GOVERNMENT'S POSSIBLE USE OF THE ARMY TO INTERVENE IS HAMPERED BY FEARS THAT THIS WOULD ONLY CATALYZE FACTIONAL DIVISIONS IN THE ARMED FORCES AND PERHAPS PROVOKE A CIVIL WAR WITH A LEFT THAT HAS GAINED SIGNI-FICANTLY IN STRENGTH OVER THE PAST FEW MONTHS.

ATTEMPT ON SADAT'S LIFE

SEPT. 10 (IPS)--THE BAGHDAD VOICE OF PALESTINE RADIO REPORTS AN UNSUCCESSFUL ASSASSINATION ATTEMPT THIS EVENING AGAINST EGYPTIAN PRESIDENT ANWAR SADAT, ACCORDING TO BRITISH BROADCASTING CORPORA-TION. SADAT IS REPORTED TO HAVE "MIRACULOUSLY ESCAPED."

II. WORLD PRESS SUMMARY - CONTINENTAL NEWS

HOUSE COMMITTEE MAY INVESTIGATE CIA ROLE IN PORTUGAL

SEPT. 10 (IPS)--THE HOUSE INTELLIGENCE COMMITTEE MAY BE INVESTIGAT-ING CIA INTERVENTION IN PORTUGAL NEXT WEEK. ACCORDING TO A SOURCE CLOSE TO THE COMMITTEE, THE COMMITTEE WILL BE INVESTIGATING CIA "INTELLIGENCE CAPABILITIES" IN THE MIDDLE EAST TOMORROW AND IN PORTUGAL ON SEPT. 18. THE COMMITTEE MAY POSSIBLY EXPAND ITS IN-VESTIGATION TO CIA INTERFERENCE IN PORTUGAL, THE SOURCE SAID.

GEORGE BALL ATTACKS KISSINGER MIDEAST POLICY

SEPT. 10 (IPS)--IN A POWERFUL STATEMENT OF GROWING BOURGEOIS OPP-OSITION TO HENRY KISSINGER'S MIDEAST DIPLOMACY, FORMER U.S. UNDER-SECRETARY OF STATE GEORGE BALL SCORES KISSINGER'S EFFORTS AS AN ATTEMPT TO "BUY TIME" THAT THREATENS TO LEAD TO A "PROXY WAR" BET-WEEN THE U.S. AND THE SOVIETS. WRITING IN THE CURRENT ISSUE OF NEWSWEEK, BALL DEMANDS INSTEAD THAT THE U.S. PUT FORTH "AMERICAN PRINCIPLES FOR AN OVER-ALL SETTLEMENT."

"NO MATTER WHAT GESTURES WE MAY MAKE IN THE WEEKS AHEAD," BALL ADDS, "IT IS SMOKING OPIUM TO ASSUME WE CAN GO FURTHER WITH STEP-BY-STEP DIPLOMACY." THIS DIPLOMACY, HE CHARGES, HAS REMOVED THE LEVERAGE OF "MODERATE" EGYPTIAN PRESIDENT SADAT UPON OTHER ARABS, THEREBY FORCING THE ARAB STATES TO DEPEND MORE ON THE SOVIETS AND ADVANCING THE UNITY OF ANTI-U.S. ARAB COUNTRIES.

DAILY NEWS UNEARTHS TIMES ANTI-NCLC LIES

SEPT. 10 (IPS)--IN A QUICK PASTE-IT-UP AND GET-IT-OUT EXAMPLE OF CIA PROPAGANDA, THE NEW YORK DAILY NEWS RESPONDED TO THE GROWING SUPPORT IN THE NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATURE FOR THE DEBT MORATORIUM BILL BY LIBELING THE NATIONAL CAUCUS OF LABOR COMMITTEES. THE PAGE

FIVE PATCHWORK JOB REFERS TO NCLC HALFWAY THROUGH A RAMBLING DES-CRIPTION OF SUCH CIA-DIRECTED GANGS AS THE SLA AND THE WEATHER UNDERGROUND SANDWICHING THE NCLC BETWEEN THE MANSON FAMILY AND THE CHILDREN OF GOD! BUT THERE IS A THIRD NEW YORK BASEDPOLITICAL GROUP...AND (THE NCLC) USES A MORE SUBTLE FORM OF TERROR."

(THE ARTICLE) THEN GOES ON TO RECOUNT SLANDERS ORIGINALLY TRIED OUT IN THE NEW YORK TIMES IN JANUARY OF 1974. THE "CRAZY " LINE WAS THOUGHT TO HAVE DIED WHEN ITS CONDUIT, PAUL MONTGOMERY, WAS RELEGATED TO THE SPORTS PAGE SEVERAL MONTHS LATER.

III. ICLC INTELLIGENCE AND ORGANIZING REPORT

PAKISTAN CALLS FOR DEBT MORATORIUM

UNITED NATIONS, SEPT. 10 (IPS)--SPEAKING ON BEHALF OF THE PAKIS-TANI GOVERNMENT AT THE UNITED NATIONS SPECIAL SESSION, MR. FEROZ KAISER GAVE HIS COUNTRY'S FULL SUPPORT TO A DEBT MORATORIUM, AND CALLED UPON THE UN SPECIAL SESSION TO ACT ON IT. KAISER STATED THAT "CANCELLATION, MORATORIUM OR RESCHEDULING OF THE LARGE EXTERNAL DEBTS CONTRACTED IS NOW AN IMPERATIVE NECESSITY...THE DEVELOPMENT OBJECTIVES FOR WHICH THE DEBTS WERE CONTRACTED HAVE NOT BEEN ACHIEVED DUE TO LACK OF PROGRESS IN OTHER AREAS, SUCH AS ACCESS TO MARKETS FOR THE GOODS PRODUCED BY ASSISTED PROJECTS OR TECHNOLOGY TO RENDER THESE PROJECTS EFFICIENT AND COMPETITIVE.

"THE PAKISTAN DELEGATION WOULD THEREFORE PROPOSE THAT IN VIEW OF THESE SERIOUS DIFFICULTIES ENCOUNTERED BY THE DEVELOPING COUNTRIES, AN AGREEMENT IN PRINCIPLE SHOULD BE REACHED AT THIS SESSION THAT UNTIL THE OBJECTIVES FOR WHICH THE SPECIFIC DEVELOP-MENT LOANS WERE PROVIDED ARE ATTAINED, A MORATORIUM SHOULD BE PLACED ON THERI AMORTIZATION AND INTEREST PAYMENTS. THIS MEASURE WOULD BY ITSELF SUBSTANTIALLY AMELIORATE THE FINANCIAL PROBLEMS OF THE DEVELOPING COUNTRIES."

NEW YORK TRADE UNION LEADERS CO-SPONSOR DEBT MORATORIUM HEARINGS WITH USLP

SEPT. 10 (IPS)--CHARLES SERRETTE, PRESIDENT OF THE NEW YORK COALITION OF BLACK TRADE UNIONISTS (CBTU) AND VICE-PRESIDENT OF COMMUNICATIONS WORKERS OF AMERICA (CWA) #1101, AND ED CROSS, PRESIDENT OF COMPRESSED AIR AND TUNNEL WORKERS #147 AGREED TODAY TO CO-SPONSOR PUBLIC HEARINGS ON A DEBT MORATORIUM IN NEW YORK CITY WITH THE U.S. LABOR PARTY.

SERRETTE STATED TODAY THAT HE WOULD EXTEND AN INVITATION TO THE HEARINGS TO NEW YORK'S UNITED FEDERATION OF TEACHERS, NOW STRIKING OVER INCREASED CLASS SIZE CAUSED BY CITY BUDGET CUTS.

FORMER AGENT EXPOSES GOV'T TERRORISM

TRENTON, N.J. SEPT. 10 (IPS) -- ROY FRANKHAUSER, FORMER AGENT OF THE FBI AND OTHER FEDERAL AGENCIES, HELD A PRESS CONFERENCE HERE TODAY WITH THE U.S. LABOR PARTY.

THE CONFERENCE WAS ORGANIZED BY THE LABOR PARTY AT MR. FRANK-HAUSER'S REQUEST, TO DETAIL FOR THE PRESS HIS EXPERIENCES AS AN AGENT DATING FROM 1971, WHICH PROVE THAT THE U.S. GOVERNMENT, THE NATIONAL SECURITY AGENCY, AND THE COVERT INTELLIGENCE COMMUNITY HAS "AS A MATTER OF CONSCIOUS POLICY CREATED THE PREPONDERANCE OF TERRORIST ACTIVITIES IN THIS COUNTRY." FRANKHAUSER ALSO CHARGED THAT "GOVERNMENT AGENCIES, IN PARTICULAR THE ATF, FBI, AND LEAA, HAVE REPEATEDLY SOUGHT TO THWART ANY PUBLIC INVESTIGATIONS" INTO THESE MATTERS.

IN PARTICULAR, FRANKHAUSER REVEALED AN OPERATION BY THE FBI AGAINST BERKS COUNTY (PA.) DISTRICT ATTORNEY ROBERT VAN HOOVE DURING THE LATTER PART OF 1971 AT WHICH TIME VAN HOOVE WAS CLOSE TO PUTTING ATF AND FBI IN COMPROMISING POSITIONS REGARDING THEIR ROLE IN CRIME IN THAT REGION.

THE CONFERENCE WAS ATTENDED BY THE WASHINGTON STAR, THE ASSOCIA-TED PRESS, THE PHILADELPHIA BULLETIN, AND THE PHILADELPHIA IN-QUIRER.

BLACK UNION LEADER ENDORSES PORTUGAL/ANGOLA DEFENSE COMMITTEES

SEPT. 10 (IPS)--DENNIS SERRETTE, PRESIDENT OF THE NEW YORK COALI-TION OF BLACK TRADE UNIONISTS, TODAY ENDORSED THE WORK OF COM-MITTEES TO DEFEND THE REVOLUTIONS IN PORTUGAL AND ANGOLA, NOW BEING FORMED AT LABOR PARTY INITIATIVE ACROSS THE COUNTRY. A PROPONENT OF DEBT MORATORIA AND DEVELOPMENT, SERRETTE PLEDGED TO AID THE WORK OF THE COMMITTEES IN WHATEVER WAY POSSIBLE.
