WILLY BRANDT PERSONAL SECRETARY ATTENDED THE LIVORNO STRATEGY SESSION BETWEEN BERLINGUER AND CARRILLO

OCT. 22 (IPS)—RELIABLE JOURNALIST SOURCES TOLD THE IPS TODAY THAT WEST GERMAN SOCIAL DEMOCRATIC PARTY CHAIRMAN WILLY BRANDT'S "PERSONAL SECRETARY" SAT IN ON THE STRATEGY SESSION BETWEEN ITALIAN COMMUNIST PARTY (PCI) GENERAL SECRETARY ENRICO BERLINGUER AND SANTIAGO CARRILLO HEAD OF THE ANTI-SOVIET SPANISH COMMUNIST PARTY (PCE) AT THE CITY OF LIVORNO (LEGHORN) ITALY IN JUNE. THE MEETING RESULTED IN THE NOTORIOUS COMMUNIQUE CARRILLO AND BERLINGUER KNOWN AS THE "LIVORNO STATEMENT" WHICH CALLED FOR PLURALIST DEMOCRACIES THROUGHOUT EUROPE.

WILLY BRANDT'S PERSONAL SECRETARY IS PRESENTLY ASSUMED TO BE HORST EMKE. HE SPOKE IN STUTTGART, WEST GERMANY YESTERDAY, AND SAID "THE ITALIAN COMMUNIST PARTY IS ONE OF THE MOST IMPORTANT FACTORS FOR LEADING ITALY OUT OF ITS PRESENT CHAOS... CARRILLO IN SPAIN IS ONE OF THE MOST COMMITTEED COMMUNIST PARTY MEMBERS IN EUROPE, COMMITTED TO DEMOCRATIC SOCIALISM."

EMKE TOOK PAINS TO NOTE THAT "THE FRENCH COMMUNIST PARTY IS COMPLETELY DIFFERENT FROM THE ITALIAN COMMUNIST PARTY."

JAPAN, IRAQ NEGOTIATING A MULTI-BILLION DEVELOPMENT PACKAGE

OCT. 22 (IPS)—THE JAPANESE GOVERNMENT HAS MADE AVAILABLE \$1 BILLION IN LOANS TO IRAQ TO PURCHASE TECHNOLOGY FROM JAPANESE COMPANIES.

THIS PRIOR COMMITMENT BY THE JAPANESE GOVERNMENT WHICH HAS NOT BEEN MADE TO ANY OTHER COUNTRY IS PART OF A MULTI-BILLION DOLLAR DEVELOPMENT PACKAGE BEING NEGOTIATED BETWEEN IRAQ AND JAPANESE COMPANIES, AN OFFICIAL OF THE JAPAN EXPORT-IMPORT BANK TOLD IPS TODAY. THE EX-IM BANK OFFICIAL POINTED OUT THAT IRAQ IS THE ONLY MEMBER OF THE OIL PRODUCERS CARTEL, OPEC, WHICH HAS GIVEN JAPAN A LONG-TERM AGREEMENT GUARANTEEING SUPPLIES OF OIL.

WHEN ASKED WHETHER JAPAN -- IN VIEW OF ITS RAPID DEPLETION DOLLAR RESERVES -- WOULD AGREE TO DIRECT BARTER ARRANGEMENTS WITH OPEC COUNTRIES ON AN OIL-FOR-TECHNOLOGY BASIS OUTSIDE OF THE DOLLAR TRADE MECHANISM, THE OFFICIAL SAID IT WAS NOT CURRENT POLICY.

OBSERVERS, HOWEVER, POINTED OUT THAT THE UNIQUE PRIOR COMMITMENT TO IRAQ, AS WELL AS THE FACT THAT PART OF THE \$1 BILLION FINANCING WOULD BE IN YEN, INDICATED THAT JAPAN WOULD, IN FACT, BE FORCED TO MEET ITS DOLLAR SHORTAGE PROBLEM THROUGH BARTER-TYPE ARRANGEMENTS.

SENATOR STEVENSON EXPOSES NEW YORK BANKS IN INTIMIDATION EFFORT
TO FORCE PASSAGE OF BAILOUT LEGISLATION

OCT. 22 (IPS)—IN AN IMPASSIONED SPEECH AT TODAY'S SENATE BANKING COMMITTEE HEARINGS ON AID TO NEW YORK CITY, ADLAI STEVENSON (D-ILL.) CHARGED THAT "INTIMIDATION OF SOME OF THE FOREMOST BANKERS IN THE U.S. IS GOING ON FROM REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NEW YORK BANKS."

FOLLOWING THE ADJOURNMENT OF THE COMMITTEE HEARINGS, SEN. STEVENSON TOLD IPS THAT INTERNATIONAL SOURCES HAD CONVINCED HIM A FEDERAL BAILOUT WOULD CAUSE A QUICK COLLAPSE OF THE U.S. ECONOMY.

STEVENSON, WHO'S FAMILY HAS LONG REPRESENTED CHICAGO'S INDUSTRIAL INTERESTS, TOLD THE BANKING COMMITTEE THAT HE HAD SPOKEN PERSONALLY TO THE HEAD OF ONE OF THE LARGEST U.S. BANKS WHO, ALTHOUGH SUBJECTED TO THIS INTIMIDATION, WAS WILLING TO TELL ALL IN TESTIMONY. STEVENSON LATER IDENTIFIED THIS BANKER AS MR. STULTZ CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF THE AMERICAN NATIONAL BANK AND TRUST COMPANY OF CHICAGO.

STEVENSON'S DRAMATIC MOVES, REFLECTIVE OF THE GROWING ANTI-ROCKEFELLER POLITICIZATION WITHIN CONGRESS, CONVERGES WITH UNPRECEDENTED EUROPEAN AND THIRD WORLD MOTION TO DUMP THE DOLLAR OPTING INSTEAD FOR A NEW PRO-DEVELOPMENT MONETARY SYSTEM. WELL AWARE THAT A FEDERAL BAILOUT IS SIMPLY A ROLL OVER OF DOLLAR DEBT FOR DAVID ROCKEFELLER'S BANKS, STEVENSON, SUPPORTED BY SEN. BIDEN (D-DEL), DEMANDED A CONTINUATION OF HEARINGS BECAUSE "EVERY WITNESS WHO HAS EXPRESSED SUPPORT FOR THE LOAN GUARANTEE HAS BEEN INTERESTED PARTY." SEN. STEVENSON HAS PREPARED A LONG LIST OF INDIVIDUALS WITH "OPPOSING VIEWS" WHO ARE INTERESTED IN TESTIFYING.

SEN. STEVENSON'S LEADING ROLE IN THE REVOLT AGAINST ROCKEFELLER NOW OCCURRING IN CONGRESS WAS CAPTURED IN A NEW YORK POST ARTICLE WHICH APPEARED EARLIER IN THE DAY. WITH THE SENATE BANKING COMMITTEE'S PROCEDURAL VOTE TO DISCUSS A FEDERAL LOAN GUARANTEES BARELY SQUEAKING THROUGH (7-6 AFFIRMATIVE VOTE), STEVENSON'S VOTE ON THE LEGISLATION ITSELF IS CONSIDERED DECISIVE. SENATE STAFF MEMBERS WERE SURPRISED, THE POST REPORTS, OF STEVENSON'S FORCEFUL ARGUMENTS YESTERDAY THAT THE COMMITTEE WAS RUSHING TO A HASTY JUDGMENT. "THERE IS AN OBLIGATION HERE BUT WHO IS IT TO?" STEVENSON ASKED. "THE BANKERS? THE INVESTORS?"

JAPANESE PRESS COVERS STOLTENBERG WITH PRAISE

OCT. 22 (IPS)—WEST GERMAN CHRISTIAN DEMOCRATIC UNION LEADER, GERHARD STOLTENBERG, HAS WARNED THE JAPANESE TO "RESIST THE TEMPTATION TO TURN PROTECTIONIST" AND CALLED FOR "WORLDWIDE TALKS" WHICH "ARE NEEDED TO PROMOTE INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION IN FINANCIAL MONETARY, TRADE AND OTHER AREAS."

IN AN INTERVIEW PUBLISHED OCT. 13 IN THE MAJOR JAPANESE DAILY, ASHAI, STOLTENBERG STATED THAT A HIGH PRODUCTIVE GROWTH RATE IS POSSIBLE IN THE NEAR FUTURE. HE TERMED THE UPCOMING PARIS NORTH-SOUTH TALKS BETWEEN CONSUMERS AND PRODUCING NATIONS AND THE "GROUP OF SIX" MONETARY MEETING OF "EXTREME IMPORTANCE."

STOLTENBERG THEN WARNED JAPANESE BUSINESS AND POLITICAL LEADERS THAT A DEMOCRACY CANNOT HOLD DOWN WAGE CONSUMPTION WITHOUT PLACING ITSELF IN JEOPARDY. THE JAPANESE GOVERNMENT, UNDER ORDERS FROM THEIR CREDITORS IN NEW YORK'S ROCKEFELLER-CONTROLLED BANKS HAS RECENTLY EMBARKED UPON A MASSIVE AUSTERITY PROGRAM.

THE ASHAI WHICH GAVE THE INTERVIEW A BANNER HEADLINE: "BONN OPPOSITION LEADER CALLS FOR INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION," CALLED STOLTENBERG ONE OF THE "MOST POPULAR POLITICIANS IN GERMANY" AND THE MINISTER OF ECONOMICS IN THE WEST GERMAN SHADOW CABINET." STOLTENBERG, WHO RETURNED TO WEST GERMANY YESTERDAY AFTER NEARLY THREE WEEKS OF MEETINGS IN JAPAN, HAS NOT YET OFFICIALLY RECEIVED THE APPOINTMENT BY HIS PARTY.

WEST BERLIN CP DENOUNCES SOCIAL DEM "DARLINGS OF IMPERIALISM"

OCT. 22 (IPS)—IN AN ARTICLE ON THE SOCIAL DEMOCRACY'S SO-CALLED "THIRD WAY" BETWEEN CAPITALISM AND SOCIALISM YESTERDAY, THE WEST BERLIN COMMUNIST PARTY PAPER DIE WAHRHEIT BLASTED EDUARD BERNSTEIN AND KARL KAUTSKY, THE FOUNDERS OF THE REFORMIST CURRENT OF THE GERMAN SOCIAL DEMOCRACY (SPD), CALLING THEM "THE DARLINGS OF IMPERIALISM."

THE IDEA OF "A THIRD WAY," THE ARTICLE CHARGED, IS A "CONSCIOUS PROGRAM TO MAINTAIN THE POWER OF IMPERIALISM AGAINST THE FURTHER ADVANCE OF MARXISM." "MONOPOLY CAPITAL," DIE WAHRHEIT ADDS, "WILL BE ABLE TO BEAR THE SOCIAL DEMOCRATIC VERSION OF "CO-PARTICIPATION" WITHOUT GETTING EXCITED."

WARNING OF RIGHT WING ANGOLA TAKE OVER BY TWO AFRICAN GROUPS

OCT. 22 (IPS)—LETTERS SENT TO LISBON BY THE PORTUGUESE FRIENDSHIP COMMITTEES OF MOZAMBIQUE AND GUINEA BISSEAU WARN OF TAKEOVER OF ANGOLA BY RIGHT WING FORCES OPERATING ON ORDERS FROM THE NATO-CONTROLLED PORTUGUESE GOVERNMENT.

ACCORDING TO THE LETTERS, THE SOCIAL DEMOCRATIC SIXTH PROVISIONAL GOVERNMENT WILL SEND CRACK RIGHT WING COMMANDO UNITS TO ANGOLA ON NOVEMBER 11, THE DATE SET FOR ANGOLAN INDEPENDENCE. THESE UNITS WILL BREAK THE HOLD OF THE HEGEMONIC POLITICAL FORCE IN THE COUNTRY, THE PRO-SOVIET POPULAR MOVEMENT, THE MPLA, AND PROCEED TO INSTALL THE U.S. STATE DEPARTMENT-CHINESE BACKED NATIONAL FRONT, THE FNLA, AS THE "LEGITIMATE" ANGOLAN GOVERNMENT.

ONCE THE MPLA IS SMASHED, THE COMMANDO UNITS WOULD RETURN TO PORTUGAL, THE LETTERS REPORT, TAKING WITH THEM THOUSANDS OF ANGOLAN REFUGEES. THESE REFUGEES WOULD THEN BE RECRUITED INTO THE FASCIST SHOCK TROOPS THAT GOVERNMENT IS NOW TRYING TO CREATE FOR DEPLOYMENT AGAINST THE PORTUGUESE COMMUNIST PARTY.

SIMON AND BUTZ STICK TOGETHER AGAINST ROCKEFELLER POLICY

OCT. 22 (IPS)—UNDER QUESTIONING FROM SENATORS CASE (D-NJ), SYMINGTON, (D-MO), AND JAVITTS (R-NY) AT SENATE FOREIGN RELATIONS COMMITTEE TODAY, SECRETARY OF THE TREASURY WILLIAM SIMON AND SECRETARY OF AGRICULTURE EARL BUTZ TOOK A COMMON STAND AGAINST THE STATE DEPARTMENT'S AND NATIONAL SECURITY COUNCIL'S (NSC) CONDUCT OF THE "OIL FOR GRAIN" NEGOTIATIONS AGAINST THE SOVIET UNION.

SECRETARY OF COMMERCE RODGERS MORTON LED OFF THE TESTIMONY BY THE FEUDING ADMINISTRATION OFFICIALS ADMITTING TO SEN. JAVITTS THAT HE WAS LETTING SECRETARY OF STATE HENRY KISSINGER TAKE OVER THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE COMMODITY AGREEMENTS OUTLINED AT THE RECENT SPECIAL SESSION OF THE UNITED NATIONS. SIMON HOWEVER STATED THAT HE WAS IN CLOSE AGREEMENT WITH BUTZ, WHO HAD ATTACKED THE USE OF FOOD AS A POLITICAL WEAPON AND THE OIL-FOR-GRAIN NEGOTIATIONS. THE SOVIETS, HOWEVER, FOILED KISSINGER'S BLACKMAIL EFFORT. SIMON DESCRIBED HIS RELATIONSHIP TO BUTZ AS BEING "CLOSER THAT THE WALLPAPER IS TO THE WALL. AS A VANISHING BREED, WE FREE MARKET FREAKS HAVE TO STICK TOGETHER."

BOTH SIMON AND BUTZ HAVE OPPOSED POSITIONS ON MONETARY AND TRADE MATTERS ADVOCATED BY ASSOCIATES AND EMPLOYEES OF VICE-PRESIDENT NELSON ROCKEFELLER.

TRIBUNE BREAKS PPESS BLACKOUT CHICAGO BANKERS
CALL FOR PRODUCTION

OCT. 22 (IPS)—YESTERDAY'S CHICAGO TRIBUNE BROKE THE NATIONAL PRESS BLACKOUT ON THE CALLS FOR EXPANDED INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION BY CHICAGO MAYOR DALEY AND CHICAGO BANKER ABOUD AT MONDAY'S JOINT ECONOMIC COMMITTEE HEARINGS IN CHICAGO. THE TRIBUNE REPORTS THAT ABOUD DECLARED THAT THERE IS NO MORE IMPORTANT PRIORITY FOR THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT THAN TO PROMOTE ECONOMIC GROWTH WITHOUT INFLATION BY STIMULATING INVESTMENT IN NEW PLANTS AND EQUIPMENT. ABOUD SCORED THE INCREASING FEDERAL DEBT WHICH WAS "CROWDING" INDUSTRIAL CAPITALIST OUT OF THE CAPITAL MARKETS.

WELL PLACED CHICAGO INDUSTRIALISTS HAVE REVEALED THAT THE CHICAGO TRIBUNE, FIRST NATIONAL BANK OF CHICAGO AND INTERNATIONAL HARVESTER HAVE RECENTLY CONSOLIDATED A WORKING CONSOLIDATION WITH EACH OTHER.

GERMAN EMPLOYERS WONT PAY CHRISTMAS BONUSES

OCT. 22 (IPS)—THE WEST GERMAN FEDERAL EMPLOYERS' ASSOCIATION ANNOUNCED YESTERDAY THAT MANY COMPANIES WILL BE UNABLE TO PAY FULL CHRISTMAS BONUSES THIS YEAR, ACCORDING TO TODAY'S GERMAN DAILY THE SUEDEUTSCHE ZEITUNG. FULL CHRISTMAS BONUSES IN WEST GERMANY ARE TRADITIONALLY ONE MONTH'S PAY.
