I. PRIORITIES.

FEA HINTS OIL EMBARGO TO WRECK NORTH/SOUTH CONFERENCE
MILITARIZE WESTERN EUROPE.

WASHINGTON, D.C., DEC. 6 (IPS)—A TOP FEDERAL ENERGY ADMINISTRATION (FEA) AIDE HINTED YESTERDAY THAT THE ROCKEFELLER CABAL MAY BE PREPARING TO PROVOKE A NEW ARAB OIL EMBARGO IN ORDER TO BEAT THE PRO-DEVELOPMENT EUROPEANS, JAPANESE, IRAQIS, AND ALGERIANS INTO LINE ON THE QUESTION OF THE "NEW WORLD ECONOMIC ORDER" AND PROPOSALS FOR THE CREATION OF A NEW, NON-INTERNATIONAL MONETARY FUND WORLD CREDIT INSTITUTION AT THE UPCOMING NORTH/SOUTH CONFERENCE. THE ROCKEFELLERS ARE PRESENTLY ON A NUCLEAR WAR FOOTING TO PREVENT THE ADOPTION OF SUCH ARRANGEMENTS.

CLEMENT MALLIN, AN AIDE TO FEA CZAR FRANK ZARR, TOLD IPS: "I'M NOT SAYING THIS (AN OIL HOAX) IS LIKELY, BUT IF THESE COUNTRIES (THE ARABS) SHOULD DECIDE TO ATTEMPT TO FINISH OFF THE (NORTH/SOUTH) CONFERENCE, THEY COULD USE THE THREAT OF AN EMBARGO TO TORPEDO THE CONFERENCE."

MALLIN ALSO CONFIRMED REPORTS THAT FRANCE AND THE REST OF THE COMMON MARKET (EEC) HAVE AGREED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE "EMERGENCY ENERGY-SHARING PROGRAM" OF THE ROCKEFELLER-DOMINATED INTERNATIONAL ENERGY AGENCY, WHICH IS TO BE ACTIVATED IMMEDIATELY IN THE EVENT OF AN ARAB EMBARGO. UNDER THIS SCHEME, SCARCE ENERGY

SUPPLIES WOULD BE RATIONED OUT TO THE PARTICIPATING COUNTRIES, ENFORCING A REGIME OF STRICT, TOP-DOWN ECONOMIC CONTROL.

THE EEC ALSO AGREED TO A MINIMUM GUARANTEED OIL PRICE OF \$6 TO \$8 PER BARREL — A CONCESSION TO BRITAIN WHICH HAS BEEN HYSTERICALLY DEMANDING A FLOOR PRICE FOR ITS NEAR-BANKRUPT NORTH SEA OIL PROJECT. MALLIN COMMENTED CYNICALLY THAT THE BRITISH HAVE BEEN "UNREALISTIC" IN DEMANDING A STILL HIGHER MINIMUM PRICE OF \$12 PER BARREL, EVEN THOUGH HIS BOSS, ZARR, HAD PUBLICLY CALLED FOR AN OIL PRICE INCREASE RECENTLY WHILE IN BRITAIN.

OBSERVERS FEEL THAT ZARR AND OTHER ROCKEFELLER AGENTS HAVE MANIPULATED BRITAIN INTO PLAYING A SABOTEUR ROLE AT THE NORTH/SOUTH CONFERENCE TO PROTECT ITS NARROW INTERESTS IN THE NORTH SEA.

IN LINE WITH THIS ASSESSMENT, A TOP NEW YORK BANKING SOURCE TOLD IPS YESTERDAY THAT BRITAIN MAY JOIN THE ORGANIZATION OF PETROLEUM EXPORTING COUNTRIES (OPEC), WHERE IT WOULD ACT AS A COUNTER-GANG TO ISOLATE IRAQ (WHICH HAS BEEN INCREASING PRODUCTION, HOLDING DOWN OIL PRICES RECENTLY) AND ALGERIA.

GANDHI: OUR NEIGHBORS TRY TO SWAY US FROM DEVELOPMENT

DEC. 6 (IPS)—INDIAN PRIME MINISTER INDIRA GANDHI TOLD AN ALL-INDIA TEACHERS CONVENTION THIS WEEK THAT "MASSIVE PRESSURES ARE BEING BUILT AROUND INDIA...HUGE ARMS PILE-UP IN SOME NEIGHBORING COUNTRIES ARE COMPELLING US TO ABANDON OUR INDEPENDENT PATH OF DEVELOPMENT."

THE CIA-CONTROLLED PAKISTANI MILITARY AND THE CIA-ALIGNED MAOIST REGIME IN PEKING HAVE RECENTLY BUILT UP FORCES ALONG THE INDIAN BORDER. ACCORDING TO THE NOV. 25 TIMES OF INDIA, GANDHI WARNED INDIA'S POTENTIAL ENEMIES THAT HER COUNTRY'S BORDERS HAVE BEEN SECURED TO "MEET THREATS FROM ANY DIRECTION."

IN A SEPARATE SPEECH IN NEW DELHI THIS WEEK COM-

MUNIST PARTY OF INDIA (CPI) CHAIRMAN RAJESHMAN RAO GAVE FULL SUPPORT TO THE GANDHI GOVERNMENT, CHARGING THAT "THE IMPERIALIST-MAOIST ALLIANCE IS NOW CREATING A DANGEROUS SITUATION FOR INDIA." RAO THEN OUTLINED VARIOUS ATTEMPTS BY THE U.S. AND CHINA TO SPARK WAR ON THE SUBCONTINENT AND LAID THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE DESTABILIZATION OF THE BENGALI GOVERNMENT WITH THE CIA.

KISSINGER TO VISIT JAPAN TO PUSH SINO-JAPANESE ALLIANCE

DEC. 6 (IPS)—IN A MOVE TO INTENSIFY U.S. PRESSURE ON JAPAN TO SUPPORT A U.S.-PEKING WAR PACT AGAINST THE SOVIET UNION, SECRETARY OF STATE HENRY KISSINGER WILL VISIT JAPAN ON DECEMBER 7-8 TO "BRIEF" THE JAPANESE ON THE RECENT VISIT TO CHINA BY PRESIDENT FORD, ACCORDING TO THE NOV. 29 ASAHI NEWSPAPER.

THE THRUST OF KISSINGER'S MESSAGE TO THE JAPANESE PREVIEWED IN ARTICLES ON JAPAN-CHINESE RELATIONS, WHICH SIMULTANEOUSLY APPEARED TODAY IN TWO MAJOR WEST GERMAN PAPERS, THE FRANKFURTER RUNDSCHAU AND THE HANDELSELATT. THE TWO ALMOST IDENTICAL STORIES REPORT, IN THE FRANKFURTER RUNDSCHAU'S WORDS, "ASTONISHING TALK ABOUT THE ECONOMIC ALLIANCE" SOON TO BE CONCLUDED BETWEEN JAPAN AND CHINA, AND A SINGLE OUT FOR SPECIAL PRESSURE LIBERAL DEMOCRATIC PARTY VICE-PRESIDENT ETSUABURO SHIINA, WHO BOTH PAPERS REPORT HAS DRAMATICALLY ABANDONED HIS FORMER "ABSOLUTELY PRO-SOVIET" VIEWS. SHIINA NOW SUPPOSEDLY SUPPORTS A JAPANESE ALLIANCE WITH THE MAOISTS.

LEBANESE FASCIST TOURS ARAB CAPITOL

DEC. 6 (IPS)—PIERRE GEMAYEL, THE LEADER OF LEBANON'S FASCIST CHRISTIAN FALANGE PARTY, IS GOING TO DAMASCUS ON SATURDAY, AT THE INVITATION OF SYRIAN PRESIDENT HAFEZ ASSAD, ACCORDING TO THE BEIRUT PAPER AS-SAFIR, AS REPORTED IN YESTERDAY'S SUEDEDEUTSCHE ZEITUNG, SAYING THAT GEMAYEL HAS BEEN ALSO INVITED TO OTHER ARAB COUNTRIES, INCLUDING SAUDI ARABIA AND EGYPT. GEMAYEL TOLD JOURNALISTS THAT HE WILL AIM AT RAPPROCHEMENT BETWEEN LEBANON AND SYRIA "IF STRICT RESPECT OF THE SOVEREIGNTY OF BOTH COUNTRIES" IS OBSERVED.

SUCH AN UNPRECEDENTED TOUR OF ARAB COUNTRIES BY A PROFESSED FASCIST AND CHRISTIAN, COMBINED WITH MASSIVE EFFORTS TO CONSOLIDATE THE

RANKS OF THE MAIN PRO-ROCKEFELLER REGIMES AND PARTIES IN THE ARAB COUNTRIES, IS MOTIVATED BY THE NECESSITY OF MOVING QUICKLY AGAINST WIDESPREAD LEFTWING GAINS IN LEBANON, AND TO PREVENT A SPREAD OF THE "LEBANESE EXPERIENCE" THROUGHOUT THE ARAB WORLD.

II. INTERNATIONAL PRESS

MEXICAN FOREIGN MINISTER IN ISRAEL AS DISSENSION ON PALESTINIAN ISSUE SPREADS

DEC. 6 (IPS)—MEXICAN FOREIGN MINISTER EMILIO RABASSA ARRIVED YESTERDAY IN ISRAEL TO HOLD MEETINGS WITH ISRAELI FOREIGN MINISTER YIGAL ALLON, ACCORDING TO TODAY'S NEW YORK TIMES. MEXICO HAS BEEN A PRIME AND ACTIVE PROPONENT OF DETENTE BETWEEN ISRAEL AND THE PALESTINE LIBERATION ORGANIZATION SINCE THE VISIT OF MEXICAN PRESIDENT LUIS ECHEVERRIA TO THE MIDDLE EAST SEVERAL WEEKS AGO.

RABASSA'S VISIT COMES IN THE MIDST OF REPORTS OF GROWING SPLITS WITHIN BOTH ISRAELI GOVERNMENT AND JOURNALISTIC CIRCLES OVER THE ISSUE OF ISRAELI INITIATIVES TOWARD THE PALESTINIANS AND SOVIET EFFORTS TO BRING ABOUT AN ISRAELI-PLO DETENTE BASED ON A CONDITIONAL RECOGNITION OF THE ISRAELI STATE BY THE PLO.

AT AN ISRAELI CABINET MEETING EARLIER IN THE WEEK, FIVE MINISTERS URGED THAT ISRAEL CONSIDER NEGOTIATIONS WITH THE PLO, AND TODAY'S WASHINGTON POST REPORTS THAT DISCONTENT IN ISRAEL OVER RECENT BOMBING RAIDS IN LEBANON MIGHT LEAD TO A "BROAD DEBATE" OVER THE PALESTINIAN QUESTION AS A WHOLE.

VARIOUS REPORTS HAVE INDICATED A SPLIT BETWEEN HAWKISH ISRAELI PRIME MINISTER RABIN AND ALLON ON THE PALESTINIAN QUESTION. MOST RECENTLY, THE NEWSPAPER OF THE HISTADRUT TRADE UNION CONFEDERATION, DAVAR, REPORTS THAT A "CONFRONTATION IS POSSIBLE" BETWEEN THE TWO.

CZECH PARTY LOOKS FOR "FIGHTING DOCUMENT" AT EURO CP CONFERENCE

DEC. 6 (IPS)—VASIL BILAK, A MEMBER OF THE POLITBURO OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY, TOLD A MEETING OF TRADE UNION REPRESENTATIVES IN PRAGUE THAT HIS PARTY IS AIMING FOR THE UPCOMING EUROPEAN COMMUNIST PARTIES' CONFERENCE TO PRODUCE "A FIGHTING DOCUMENT" WHICH WILL PERMIT UNITY IN DEVELOPING NEW INITIATIVES CORRESPONDING TO THE "URGENCY OF SECURING PEACE IN EUROPE." HIS REMARKS WERE REPORTED OVER STIMME DER DDR YESTERDAY.

CHARGE BLUMENTHAL WITH PERJURY IN MOVE TO CRACK WHIP ON ANTI-AUSTERITY FORCES IN N.Y. STATE LEGISLATURE

DEC. 6 (IPS)—NEW YORK STATE ASSEMBLY MAJORITY LEADER ALBERT H. BLUMENTHAL (D-NY) WAS INDICTED ON EIGHT COUNTS OF PERJURY YESTERDAY

FOR ALLEGEDLY LYING BEFORE TWO PANELS ABOUT WHAT HE SAID AT A 1971 HEALTH DEPT. MEETING CONCERNING NURSING HOME ENTREPRENEUR BERNARD BERGMAN.

IN SURRENDERING AT THE OFFICE OF NURSING HOME SPECIAL PROSECUTOR CHARLES J. HYNES EARLY YESTERDAY, BLUMENTHAL SAID THAT "THE CHARGE OF PERJURY IS UNFOUNDED AND OUTRAGEOUS" AND IS SO FAR-FETCHED AND SO MOTIVATED BY POLITICAL SENSATIONALISM THAT IT WILL FALL ON ITS FACE," ACCORDING TO YESTERDAY'S NEW YORK POST.

THE SO-CALLED "NURSING HOME SCANDAL" SURROUNDING BERGMAN, WHO HAD EXTENSIVE DEALINGS WITH MANY NEW YORK POLITICIANS, WAS STIRRED UP LAST WINTER BY ROCKEFELLER-AGENT ASSEMBLYMAN ANDREW STEIN (D-MAN) AS PART OF A PLAN TO WATERGATE DEMOCRATIC MACHINE POLITICIANS WHO, ROCKEFELLER FORCES SUSPECTED, WOULD TEND TO FOOTDRAG ON THE QUESTION OF IMPLEMENTING AUSTERITY.

INFORMED POLITICAL OBSERVERS FEEL THAT MAJORITY LEADER BLUMENTHAL'S INDICTMENT IS MOST CLOSELY CONNECTED WITH HIS FAILURE TO DELIVER ENOUGH ASSEMBLY DEMOCRATIC VOTES TO PASS SPECIAL TAX INCREASES FOR NEW YORK CITY LAST MONTH WHICH WERE SOUGHT BY ROCKEFELLER FORCES IN ORDER TO WIN PRESIDENT FORD'S ENDORSEMENT OF A LIMITED FEDERAL BAILOUT OF THE NEW YORK BANKS. THE TAX INCREASES WERE FINALLY PASSED WITH THE SUPPORT OF THE ASSEMBLY'S REPUBLICAN MINORITY AFTER EXTENSIVE NEGOTIATIONS BY ROCKEFELLER-AGENT GOV. HUGH CAREY. CAREY IS NOW SEEKING ADDITIONAL AUSTERITY MOVES FOR UPSTATE NEW YORKERS, AND WILL FACE DIFFICULTY IN GETTING THE ASSEMBLY REPUBLICANS HEADED BY ASSEMBLYMAN PERRY DURYEA (R-MONTAUK)—HIMSELF THE TARGET OF AN UNSUCCESSFUL ROCKEFELLER-INITIATED FRAME-UP IN 1974—TO SUPPORT THEM.

BLUMENTHAL HAD SUPPORTED THE CAREY AUSTERITY PACKAGE—THOUGH APPARENTLY NOT HARD ENOUGH.

LEAA HARASSMENT OF CUBAN DELEGATION TO THE UN

DEC. 6 (IPS)—NEW YORK DAILY NEWS OF DEC. 3 REPORTS THAT TWO MEMBERS OF THE CUBAN DELEGATION TO THE UNITED NATIONS WERE PICKED UP BY NASSAU COUNTY POLICE ON BANK ROBBERY CHARGES LAST WEEK, HANDCUFFED AND INTERROGATED DESPITE THEIR DIPLOMATIC IMMUNITY. POLICE OFFICERS CLAIM THE TWO CUBANS' LACK OF PROPER IDENTIFICATION AND POOR ENGLISH CAUSED THEM TO BE SUSPECTED AS POSSIBLE BANK THIEVES, BUT CUBAN AMBASSADOR RICARDO ALARCO WAS INCENSED AT WHAT HE CONSIDERED OBVIOUS HARASSMENT OF HIS DELEGATION. IN A FORMAL PROTEST TO U.N. SECRETARY GENERAL KURT WALDHEIM, ALARCO DECLARED: "MINIMUM CONDITIONS INDISPENSABLE TO THE FUNCTIONING OF THE UNITED NATIONS DO NOT EXIST" IN THE U.S.

THE RECENTLY ELECTED NASSAU COUNTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY, DENNIS DILLON, WAS FORMERLY A MEMBER OF A JUSTICE DEPARTMENT "ORGANIZED CRIME STRIKE FORCE"—AN OPERATION CONTROLLED BY LAW ENFORCEMENT ASSISTANCE ADMINISTRATION (LEAA).

POLICE INFILTRATOR OF USLP IN ST. LOUIS EXPOSED

ST. LOUIS, DEC. 6 (IPS)—U.S. LABOR PARTY OFFICIALS IN ST. LOUIS YESTERDAY REVEALED THAT THEY POSSESS EXTENSIVE EVIDENCE, INCLUDING TAPE RECORDINGS AND AFFIDAVITS, INDICATING THAT A POLICE AGENT NAMED HAMILTON LEMUR HAS TRIED FOR THE PAST YEAR TO INFILTRATE THE USLP, AND HAS PARTICIPATED IN A WIDE VARIETY OF DISRUPTIVE ACTIVITIES AGAINST THE PARTY INCLUDING AN ATTEMPT TO SET UP TWO USLP MEMBERS FOR A DRUG FRAMEUP. LEMUR DISPLAYED POLICE IDENTIFICATION TO ORGANIZERS WHO MET HIM THIS WEEK IN ST. LOUIS.

THE USLP IS FURTHER INVESTIGATING THE POSSIBLE CONNECTION OF LEMUR TO FBI SPONSORED DISRUPTIONS OF THE 1972 REPUBLICAN CONVENTION.

THE USLP SAID THAT THE LEMUR CASE IS SOON TO BE PUT IN THE HANDS OF ATTORNEYS AND THAT IT IS PLANNING LEGAL ACTION AGAINST HIM. THE

EXPOSURE COMES WITHIN A WEEK OF THE USLP'S DISCOVERY OF A SECRET SERVICE "RED DOT" AGENT, GEORGE LITTLEWOOD, WHO HAD INFILTRATED THE BOSTON LABOR PARTY BRANCH TO CARRY ON SIMILAR ILLEGAL DISRUPTIVE ACTIVITIES.
